31 October 2013 – Ambassador Leah M. Basinang Ruiz paid a second courtesy call on H.E. Dr. Hussein Al Hajj Hassan, Minister of Agriculture of Lebanon, on 30 October 2013 to update him on developments in the bilateral relationship and to further explore the prospects for cooperation in the area of agricultural trade. His Adviser, Dr. Salah Hajj Hassan, was also present.

Ambassador Ruiz informed Minister Hassan that she is very happy to see Philippine pineapple already being sold in the Lebanese supermarkets and fruit stands.
